


YOU MAY HAVE A HERNIA

Ventral Hernia Facts:

Fact 1: A hernia is a hole or defect in the abdominal wall that allows the internal organs to protrude outward under the skin.

Fact 2: Once formed a hernia will not go away until surgically repaired, if not repaired it will increase in size over time and increase the risks for complications.

Fact 3: Today, mesh implants are most often used to reinforce the surgically repaired hernia to reduce the chance of hernia recurrence.

MODIFIABLE RISK FACTORS FOR HERNIA REPAIR:

- 1) Body Mass Index
- 2) Smoking
- 3) Immunosuppression
- 4) Severe Comorbidity
- 5) Inactivity
